**PRIVACY NOTICE—MEDICAL INFORMATION  
ATTACHMENT FOR RESIDENTS OF TEXAS**

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**Sexual Orientation:** We will not consider a person's sexual orientation when issuing or underwriting insurance.

**HIV/AIDS-Related Tests:** If we request an HIV/AIDS-Related test, you will be provided with a special consent form to authorize the test and disclosure of test results.

**Domestic Abuse:** We will not require an applicant to reveal whether the applicant has been or may become a victim of family violence. We will not make certain underwriting decisions based on an individual's status as a victim of family violence. We will not release information relating to an individual's status as a victim of family violence except as provided by Texas or federal law.

**Genetic Information:** We do not use genetic information to determine eligibility of coverage under a group insurance plan. We will not disclose, and cannot be forced to disclose even by a subpoena, genetic information about a person without a special consent form from the person. A person who submits to a genetic test has the right to know the results, even if the federal privacy law would otherwise deny the person access to that information.

**Policy Numbers:** We may not disclose policy numbers to outside third parties for use in telemarketing, direct mail or marketing through electronic mail.

**Utilization Review:** Utilization review is the process by which an insurer determines if a proposed medical procedure is medically necessary. If a person requests access to or a copy of information we have about them relating to utilization review, then within 10 days of our receipt of the request we will:

- Inform the person in writing of the nature and substance of the information.
- and
- Allow the person to see and copy the information in person or obtain a copy by mail.

Under Texas law, our rights to deny a person access to Medical Information are more limited than under federal law.

Our charges for providing a copy may not exceed 10 cents a page. If the information is coded, we will translate it into plain language.
